The Cities of West St. Paul and Sunfish Lake are Excited to Announce their Partnership with CODERED and NIXLE. They are two secure high-tech notification services that offer West St. Paul and Sunfish Lake citizens the opportunity to receive Emergency and Neighborhood Information via email, text messaging or through a dedicated telephone line simply by subscribing to the online services.



CODE RED

The **CODE RED** alert system is a new high-tech notification system. It allows public safety officials to quickly warn residents and businesses of emergency situations in their neighborhoods. The **CODE RED** software is operated by the Dakota County Communications Center (DCC). It combines computerized mapping technology with a high speed telephone system to deliver telephone messages to subscribing members. The system also provides text and email notifications at a rate of thousands of messages per minute.

The DCC, along with the West St. Paul police and fire officials, expect **CODE RED** to be used in situations warranting protective actions, such as a hazardous chemical spill or an armed suspect search in the area. It will also be used to request the public's assistance in finding missing or abducted children or adults. At the request of public safety, the DCC will record a message, establish a notification area and send the message over a dedicated telephone line to all mobile phones,

text devices and email addresses registered within the notification area. Residents, Business owners and anyone with a vested interest in West St. Paul and/or Sunfish Lake are encouraged to self-register. Including people who rely on cellular phones daily for information or people who have recently moved into the communities of West St. Paul or Sunfish Lake.

NIXLE is a standardized secure, and certified communication platform that provides accurate neighborhood level public safety information as well as community events information to residents and businesses in West St. Paul and Sunfish Lake.



Public safety Alerts, up to the minute need to know information; such as advisories, reminders, and last minute cancellations; municipal and community news, happenings, events, and any other relevant information will be sent via mobile phone, email, or simple web access at www.nixle.com.

Users will receive only the information they request upon registration, however, additions and deletions can only be made to the user account by using the secure user id and password given at the time of registration.
