

Forester's Report 6 1 2017

There were five burning permits issued during May. Burning permits are generally available until fall.

The annual Arbor Day Green Fair was held on Saturday, May 6th. Information on tree planting, recycling, native bees, plus free recycling of old tires was available. Several trees were planted by members of the Sunfish Lake Tree Board including 3 Japanese tree lilacs, 3 New Horizon elms, and 2 Manchurian ash trees. The students who set up a display about native bees and spoke with participants was a big hit.

The water outlets from Sunfish Lake and Horseshoe Lake are checked weekly and cleared of debris as needed. No new tree issues during May this year.
