

Forester's Report 8 31 2017

There was one burning permit issued during August. Burning permits are generally available until fall.

Seedheads of wild parsnip were collected from the north Musser Park meadow and disposed of to reduce future parsnip weed population.

A fallen poplar was cleared from Charlton Road. It was blocking both lanes.

Future wildflower planting locations in Musser Park were sprayed with Roundup in preparation for seeding late this fall.

Met with the owner at 273 Salem Church Road regarding tree removals and landscaping. A permit application and other documents are expected.

Mowed around young trees in Musser Park. Rough Cutt has been contacted to mow along city streets and the north Musser Park meadow.

Various discussions with residents regarding tree questions during the month.
