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The City held its Comprehensive Plan Open House on Wednesday September 20, 2017. The Open House saw several suggestions that residents would like to see added to the Comprehensive Plan as follows:

Deer Hunting. A resident expressed interest in seeing the deer hunting expanded in the City. The resident was informed that the City has a deer management plan and it is a topic of controversy in the City, as some residents want more hunting and some want less or none at all.

Community Trail. Residents expressed interest in a community trail through the City. The trail would not necessarily run along any specific road, but may be a combination of following a road and running along other easements.

Sound Barrier Wall Along I-494. Residents supported a sound barrier installation along I-494. An installation like this would be funded by MnDOT since the right-of-way is controlled by the State. However, the Comprehensive Plan can be updated to include a section that would support such a project.

Tree Plantings Along I-494. The City Forester has planted trees along I-494 in the past. Residents expressed approval of this project and would like to see it continue on a regular basis. Residents asked if this can be put into the Comprehensive Plan showing support for this project.

The next step for the Comprehensive Plan update is to meet as a Task Force and discuss the updates that were recommended from residents at the open house.
