

Forester's Report 6 30 2018

The Welcome to Sunfish Lake committee met on June 6 at the Heartland Credit Union community room.

The first series of City lake water samples have been consolidated and forwarded to the CAMP program for processing.

Received a complaint that the resident at 273 Salem Church Road had taken down numerous trees near the property boundary with 245 Salem Church Road. A site visit confirmed that seven live pines (2-11", 4-14" and 1-15" diameter) and three 8" diameter live spruce trees were removed from within the east property setback. Received another call about additional clearing being done but that appears to have been a dead oak. Left "Tree Removal Guide" in door on 6/29/18.

Walking trails were mowed in Musser Park, Harmon Park and along Salem Church Road. Mowed around young trees along Salem Church Road to reduce competition from tall grass and sumac. Wildflower plantings were mowed as needed and a final area in Musser Park was mowed to begin preparation for wildflower seeding this fall.
