

Forester's Report 4 30 19

Four burning permits were issued during April.

Ice out on Horseshoe Lake on April 7th. Our other lakes ice out at about the same time.

Monitored outflow from Sunfish Lake weekly and adjusted sandbags as necessary to maintain steady outflow. Cleared partial blockages in ditch near outflow to prevent water flowing on Charlton Road again this spring.

Checked trees and road ice conditions after recent spring blizzards.

The Welcome Committee met on April 23rd at the Heartland Credit Union.

Arbor Day newsletter was mailed out on April 20th.

A reminder that Arbor Day Green Fair is Saturday, May 4th starting at 10 am and everyone is encouraged to come and help plant a few trees in Musser Park and buy a few trees to plant at home.

Consulted with Planner regarding a chicken permit, various building applications and tree removals for equipment access.

Water flow out of Sunfish Lake was closed on April 29 to allow utility work along Charlton Road to be completed during that week. When work is completed outlet will be reopened.
