- Open line – party sounds confused, slight language barrier. Confirmed address. Mistake dial.

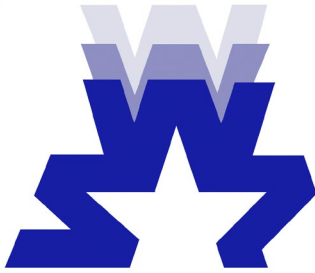
Burglar/Holdup/Panic Alarm
