SUBJECT: Calls for Service -February 20, 2024 – March 19, 2024 and Public Safety Report

Below is a summary of the calls for service from February 20, 2024 through March 19, 2024.

Burglary Alarm

- All doors and windows secure. Nothing suspicious seen. A couple of items appeared to be knocked over in the master bath. Officer left business card on front door with findings.
- Garage door alarm – received proper code to cancel.
- Residence all secure.
- Windows and doors secure. Officers had already checked the house when the cancel notice came in.
- Burglar alarm, all doors and windows secure.

Fire Alarm

- Alarm covers smoke detector. Alarm company spoke with homeowner who was changing batteries in the smoke detector which set off the alarm and alarm company requested a cancellation.

Animal Call

- Injured deer in the turn lane to go westbound 60th. State Patrol looking for assistance to dispatch the deer. Officers responded and did not locate the deer.
- Wounded coyote in the yard about 50 feet from caller's house. Coyote was limping and headed south into the tree line. Walked the property with the caller and were not able to find the coyote. Advised the homeowner to call back if the coyote returns.
- Loose black and white dog with invisible fence collar. Owner was found.
- Officer located a white and brown dog. Unable to locate the owner and the dog was transported to the South St. Paul Animal Hospital.

Juvenile Complaint

- 7 cars parked on the road with multiple juveniles. One running up and down the road. Officers spoke to juveniles and were told they were not from the area and were taking pictures of their vehicles.

Accident/No Injuries

- Mendota road and eastbound Highway 62. One vehicle rear-ended causing minor damage. Drivers exchanged information.

Road and Driving Complaint

- 2 vehicles driving erratically. One tailgating the other and driving aggressively. Last seen going northbound on Charlton. Plate doesn't match caller's description. Officers searched the area and were unable to locate the vehicles.
- Red sedan driving at high rate of speed and almost hit the caller. The sedan had to swerve off the road to avoid hitting the reporter and hit a sign and knocked it down. Caller doesn't know last direction of travel for the vehicle. Officer attempted to locate the described vehicle but was unable to find it. MNDOT was advised of the sign down.

Suspicious Activity

- Homeowner's camera recorded 2 small black cars with loud mufflers that have been racing up and down the road for the past weeks. Today they stopped and tried to walk to the front door but were scared off by the caller's dog barking. Homeowner provided footage of the two males. Officer will notify the night shift for extra patrols.

Traffic Stop

- DC – Warned for no lights being on.
- WS – Vehicle stopped for tint, no front license plate and inoperable headlight.
- MH – Warned for lane line violation.

911 Hangup

- Dispatch received automated notification that "an owner of iPhone was involved in severe car crash". Dispatch attempting to call the number. Iphone owner called in advising son had dropped phone out of car. There was no accident or emergency. Officer found nothing obvious upon searching along Salem Church Rd. The update from dispatch came as they were searching.

Follow-up

- Unable to make contact with anyone at the residence for follow up.

Premise Check

- Patrolled the area. All appeared to be fine.

Extra Patrol

- Patrolled the Windy Hill area. Spoke with a few residents who had questions about the trailer camera.

Public Assist

- Woman came to caller's door to ask her to call the police as she is the pastor's daughter and locked herself out of the church with all her belongings inside. Female then went back to the church. The church pastor arrived and unlocked the building.

Items for Discussion

At the June 2023 Council meeting we talked about the legislative session that allocated \$23,062 to the City of Sunfish Lake for additional funds to be used for public safety related initiatives. At this meeting I brought up an idea to purchase one or two portable cameras that are mounted on electrical poles in order to record and provide real time video of locations which are of concern, such as areas of illegal dumping, suspicious activity and criminal activity. At that time, it appeared to have support by Council.

In December of 2023, the City of Sunfish Lake did receive the allocated funding and we can move forward with the purchase of a camera system. I would suggest if the Council is still in favor of this initiative, we order one camera at this time. I have received a quote from a local vendor, Mobile Pro Systems, in the amount of \$9,997.00. There is also a one-time license requirement that is an additional cost.

The West St Paul Police Department has several camera systems in use from Mobile Pro already, that is integrated into our camera management system. This addition is a simple integration into our already existing platform.

If it is the desire of the Council to move forward, I would like approval to utilize funds, not to exceed \$11,000 in order to purchase this camera system. I have attached information on the camera and the quote for your review.
